Registration forms are now available at the school office for students who will be entering kindergarten in September. **Children must be 5 years of age before December 31, 2019 to be eligible.** Copies of birth certificates, health care cards, legal land locations and 911 addresses are required at the time of registration.

## Farewell and Thank You!


It's been a great school year. We wish our departing grade twelve students the best as they navigate life beyond Daysland School. We look forward to hearing about their accomplishments in the years ahead.


