Graduation Information





Our Grade 12 students have started thinking about Graduation - they have signed up for committees, and committees are in the initial planning stages. Currently, government restrictions are not allowing for indoor gatherings like graduation, so committees have been asked to plan for a range of scenarios which can be adjusted based on quidelines set by the Alberta Government and BRSD.

These scenarios include:

- a possible change of date from May to June, or May to October (much like last year)
- a limited seating indoor gathering without a dinner
- a limited seating indoor gathering with a dinner
- an outdoor 'drive up' graduation for grads and families

At this time, these are just considerations, as nothing can be confirmed until restrictions are lifted from the government. We will continue to provide parents and grads with updated information as it is released.
