# THERE IS A TRADE FOR YOU!

- English, Math & Science 10 are common prerequisites for the trades. See the <u>high school</u> <u>entrance</u> requirements for specific courses.
- Trade schools want their students to be successful.
   Consider following the recommended path rather than the minimum requirements.

### **HOW TO BEGIN AN APPRENTICESHIP**

- 1. Choose your program
- 2. Meet entrance & eligibility requirements
- 3. Find a sponsor or employer (journeyperson)
- 4. Register as an apprenticeship

# **TRADE FOCUS - HAIRSTYLIST**

- Pre-employment route: Attend an approved program and complete your on the job training
- RAP route: Find a certified journeyperson who is willing to train you on the job. Get registered, then apply for training through MyTradesecrets account.
- CTS credits may be eligible for first period training. HS requirements include a HS diploma.
