Important Staffing Update

Over the month of August we have had a number of staffing changes. Here is an overview of how things have changed over the summer:

- Mrs. Tanton (Kindergarten) is on medical leave for the month of September. She is being replaced by Miss Alexis Pfeffer.
- Mrs. Schlaut (Grade 2) is also on medical leave to begin the year. Mrs. Christie Tucker is replacing her.
- In order to fulfill a need for a CTS teacher at CHSPS in Sedgewick, Mr. Kerslake has had his original
 assignment modified. He was scheduled to teach in a variety of classes in our Elementary. He is now

Mark and Cassie Kroetch will continue in their roles as school custodians.


First Day Information


Designated Entrances


Elementary Doors

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Student Parking

High School students that drive to school can continue to use the west parking lot. It is the same as last year and it is the closest parking lot to their assigned door. We are asking students to NOT park on the street across from the parking lot. There is overflow on the north-east side of the school if necessary.

Parent/Visitor Parking

Parents and visitors can park on the east side of the school, in front of the main entrance. There are several parking spots on the south side of the designated staff parking area. Please take note of the painted lines that mark out handicap parking, crosswalks and bus parking.

Powerschool

Parents and students can track student progress and attendance by using the Powerschool app or the website. There is a link to PowerSchool on our Daysland School webpage. If you need assistance, please contact the office.

Real Time Reporting

Daysland School is participating in the second year of a pilot program which uses PowerSchool to provide up to date marks and regular assignment comments on the app and website. This replaces the traditional report card that is sent home at different points throughout the year. The benefits are that your child receives feedback in a more timely manner to improve their learning. It also allows parents to have more current information about their child's progress and facilitate conversations between your child and his or her teacher. If you would like more information about how this system works, please contact your child's teacher or the school office.

Updated Information

Families should have received an email from School Engage over the summer asking you to update/verify student information. However, should your information change later in the school year, please contact the office directly.

Attendance

If your child is going to be away, please contact your child's teacher through email or phone. You can also contact the office directly.
